Acts Worksheet #3: Waiting for the Promise of the Father

Passage: Acts 1:12-26
Sermon: Nov. 16-17

Study Period: Nov. 11-16
Link Group Meetings: Nov. 17-22

Jesus was gone. With their own eyes the disciples had seen Him ascend to heaven. They had in their hearts a personal promise from Jesus that He would be back, but they didn't know when. What now? Should they return home to Galilee, and resume business as usual? Or should they obey Jesus' command to wait for the promise of the Father? - 1. Start your study by reading Acts 1:12-26. Where did the disciples go after Jesus ascended? Why? (1:12)**
- 2. Once they were in the city, where did they go?**
- 3. What seems to be their main activity? (1:14)**
- 4. Considering verses 4, 5, and 8, what do you think they would be praying about?**
- 5. Which woman is specifically mentioned as being part of the group? Who is with her? (1:14)**
- 6. READ verses 15-22. Who seems to be surfacing as spokesman and leader of the group?**
